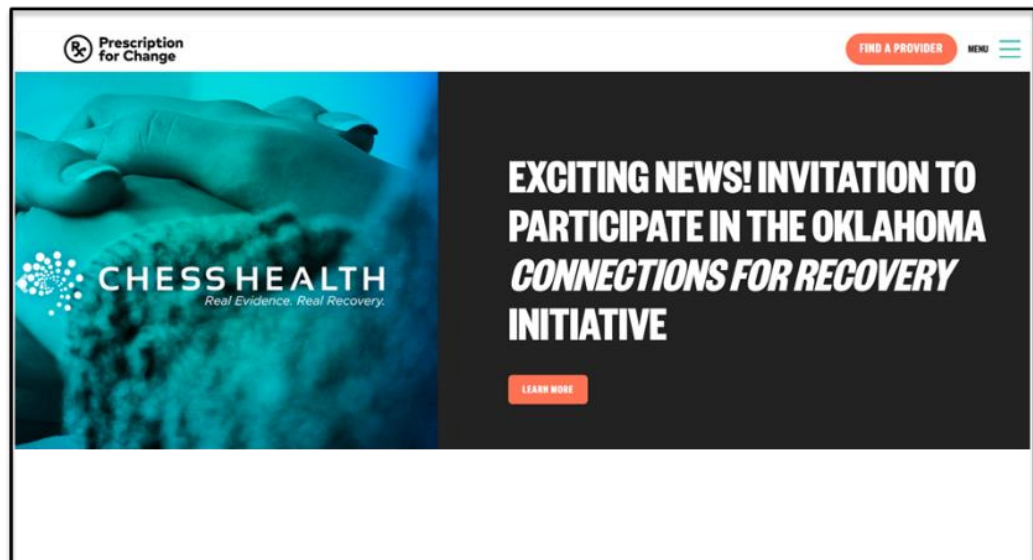

- **eIntervention**, an electronic referral management and patient engagement tool that improves continuity of care.

- **eRecovery**, combines the patient-facing *Connections App* with a platform of provider care management functionality, predictive relapse risk indicators, and analytics to reduce relapse; provides 24x7 access to a supportive peer community and other valuable recovery support tools.

These solutions support the treatment and recovery of Oklahomans with substance use disorder.

## Project Spotlight - NorthCare



This month we spotlight **NorthCare**, a Certified Community Behavioral Health Center serving individuals and families living with trauma, mental illness, or addiction so they can Live Without Limits. NorthCare implemented **eRecovery** in November 2019 and is utilizing the *Connections App* for clients in their drug court and MAT programs.

NorthCare has achieved high adoption and utilization of *Connections App* in these programs – with 100’s of patients enabled on the CHES Dashboard and 100+ active in *Connections App* week-over-week. In the last 30 days, their clients have answered 955 surveys and set 67 appointments.

NorthCare has done a fabulous job utilizing secure messaging with Discussion Groups in the *Connections App*. Their groups span a wide variety of topics such as ReMerge, Drug Courts, Community Resources, MAT Program, and even groups for exclusive use by NorthCare staff. In the last 30 days, their clients have sent **830 messages** and since going LIVE on **eRecovery**, have sent a total of **13,237 messages!**

**Patty Topp, Sr. Supervisor, Addiction and Court Related Services**, and **Jessica Wilson, Court Services Supervisor**, have embraced the use of technology at NorthCare. They love how easy the CHES Dashboard is to add patients and stay connected to clients.

The scope of the **eIntervention** project also includes OK Perinatal Quality Improvement Collab (OPQIC), 2-1-1 Oklahoma, and Family Treatment Courts. We are actively working on implementations in each of these areas. More exciting news to come in the next few months.

Also, **DHS Region 5** (northeast corner of the state for Child Welfare, Adult Protective and Developmental Disability services) is using **eIntervention** for sending referrals to all contracted providers. Team members in this region are sending referrals – approx. 80 referrals sent so far! For entities receiving these referrals, please process them within 24 hours or as quickly as possible. ODMHSAS and the CHES Health team are helping to monitor the referral response time. Thank you!
